What is Madison Writing Assistance?

MWA is a free writing support service for community members. It's funded by the Evjue Foundation, UW Anonymous Fund, and Altrusa International of Madison, Inc.

Who provides this service?

MWA writing coaches are all current graduate students at UW-Madison who are passionate about both education and (of course!) writing.

What can MWA help with?

Patrons are welcome to share a wide range of genres, including resumes, cover letters, application essays, grant proposals, creative writing, and life writing.

Can MWA provide technical support?

MWA writing coaches are happy to help patrons develop digital literacy skills like setting up email accounts, navigating word processors, and filling out online forms. They are not tech experts, though, and cannot fix phones or computers!
